BILLING SPECIALIST

Alternative Family Services, a Foster Family, Adoption, and Mental Health Agency serving children and families throughout the Bay Area, has a full-time position for a Billing Specialist in our Quality Management (QM) Division. This role will support our children's Mental Health Medi-Caid program (California's Medi-Cal program). The QM Division is responsible for compliance with Federal, State, County, and agency regulations and policies; maintenance of client clinical records; verification of insurance eligibility and claiming mental health services to insurance companies (Medi-Caid; Medi-Care; third party insurance); data analysis and reporting; and quality improvement efforts. The goals of the QM unit are to improve services to children and families, improve agency functioning, and increase the use of data-based decision making processes. The successful candidate may choose to sit in either our San Francisco or Oakland office.

KEY RESPONSIBLITIES

- Create and maintain spreadsheets and databases
- Verify Medi-Caid eligibility; report and publish results
- Review and clean mental health service data and related procedure coding
- Enter mental health service data into County MIS and Electronic Health Records (e.g., InSyst, Avatar)
- Create and run reports to verify and reconcile data entry
- Research, communicate, and bill services to Medicare and other third party insurance companies
- Monitor authorizations for treatment and service minutes
- Maintain knowledge of Medi-Cal and other insurance provisions and regulations
- Maintain compliance with Federal, State, and local regulations (e.g., HIPAA, Medi-Cal, etc.)
- Develop and manage policies and procedures to ensure billing systems are accurate and up to date
- Support Patient Accounts Unit with data cleaning, entry, filing, and reporting
- Interact with co-workers as a part of a collaborative team
- Work with minimal direct supervision while managing time and prioritizing workload appropriately
- Travel to AFS offices as needed using a personal vehicle in safe working order
